PROJECT DETAILS

Gallagher was appointed by Simons Group to undertake the groundworks, substructures and externals package for a new 62,780 sq ft warehouse and 22,000 sq ft offices in Gillingham for Henry Schein, the world's largest provider of health care products and services. The new facility has a 156 space car park, new access, service road and service yard.

The works were undertaken over 28 weeks (two weeks less than the scheduled 30 weeks), following the completion of a three week enabling/ecology works package.

Gallagher's contract included:

- Ecology works and vegetation clearance
- Cut and fill earthworks
- Construction of working and piling platforms
- Piling attendance and pile breakdown
- Construction of RC substructures and superstructures
- Drainage, attenuation and channel drainage
- Car park and access road formation
- Kerbing and paving works
- Ducting and drawpits plus BWIC services
- Hard and soft landscaping

Gallagher Aggregates Ltd took muck away to Hermitage Quarry and supplied fill material.
